RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. Pre-registration is not required.
2. The total number of specimens entered by any exhibitor is not limited; however, only one specimen of any one cultivated variety is permitted. Multiple specimens of a single cultivated variety are not permitted.
3. Exhibitors will enter the Council of Garden Clubs building via the covered entrance adjacent to the parking lot. All entries must be in place by 9:40 am. No exceptions. The show area will be cleared of all persons except judges and clerks until judging is complete.
4. All entries must be shown in clear containers. Cotton balls must be used for staging blooms. Cotton balls will be available at the venue; however, early staging is encouraged.
5. Every entry must be accompanied by a GCV entry card. Cards are in the newsletter and on the MMGC website.
6. Miniature daffodils will be shown in Class 5. A miniature daffodil is any cultivar on the current American Daffodil Society's Approved List of Miniatures.
7. There is no limit to the number of blue, red, yellow, and white ribbons awarded. An award may be withheld if in the judge's opinion, the exhibit is not worthy. Entries that are incorrectly identified will not be judged.
8. Help in identifying GCV collection daffodils may be found on the GCV website. www.gcvirginia.org Help in identifying specimens also will be available at the venue. If help is required, please arrive early.
